NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – DECEMBER 16th, 2024

CONSIDERATION OF A MORATORIUM ON SPECIAL USE PERMIT APPLICATIONS FOR SOLAR FARMS

Notice of hereby given, as per General Statutes §§ 160D-107 and 160D-601, that the Davidson County Board of Commissioners will conduct a legislative hearing on Monday, December 16th, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Commissioners Meeting Room on the fourth floor of the Davidson County Governmental Center, 913 North Greensboro Street, Lexington, North Carolina, to consider a proposed 24-month moratorium on the acceptance or processing of special use permit applications for solar farms in Davidson County, as set forth by the Davidson County Zoning Ordinance, pending consideration of amendments to such ordinance. The purpose of such public hearing is to solicit public comment on the proposed moratorium.

The total time for comments from members of the public on this matter shall be one hour. At the discretion of the chair, time for public comments may be extended. The one-hour limit does not include or affect Board deliberation time or time for members of County staff to provide information or recommendations.

As a result of the public hearing, substantial changes might be made in the advertised proposal reflecting objections, debate, and discussions at the hearing.
