NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – AUGUST 24th, 2026

CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCE IMPOSING A SIX-MONTH MORATORIUM ON DEVELOPMENT APPROVALS FOR DATA CENTERS IN DAVIDSON COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

Notice is hereby given, as per General Statutes §§ 160D-107 and 160D-601, that the Davidson County Board of Commissioners will conduct a legislative hearing on Monday, August 24th, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Commissioners Meeting Room on the fourth floor of the Davidson County Governmental Center, 913 North Greensboro Street, Lexington, North Carolina. At the hearing, the Board will consider an ordinance to impose a proposed six (6) month moratorium on development approvals for data centers, including the acceptance, processing, and approval of applications for data centers in Davidson County. The moratorium would allow the County to consider the impacts of data center facilities on utility capacity, environmental resources, public health, and similar matters, and to prepare and adopt amendments to the Davidson County Zoning Ordinance to comprehensively address data centers. The purpose of the public hearing is to solicit public comment on the proposed moratorium.

The total time for comments from members of the public on this matter shall be one hour, with a limit of three minutes per speaker. At the discretion of the chair, time for public comments may be extended. The one-hour limit does not include or affect Board deliberation time or time for members of County staff to provide information or recommendations.

As a result of the public hearing, substantial changes may be made in the advertised proposal reflecting objections, debate, and discussions at the hearing.
